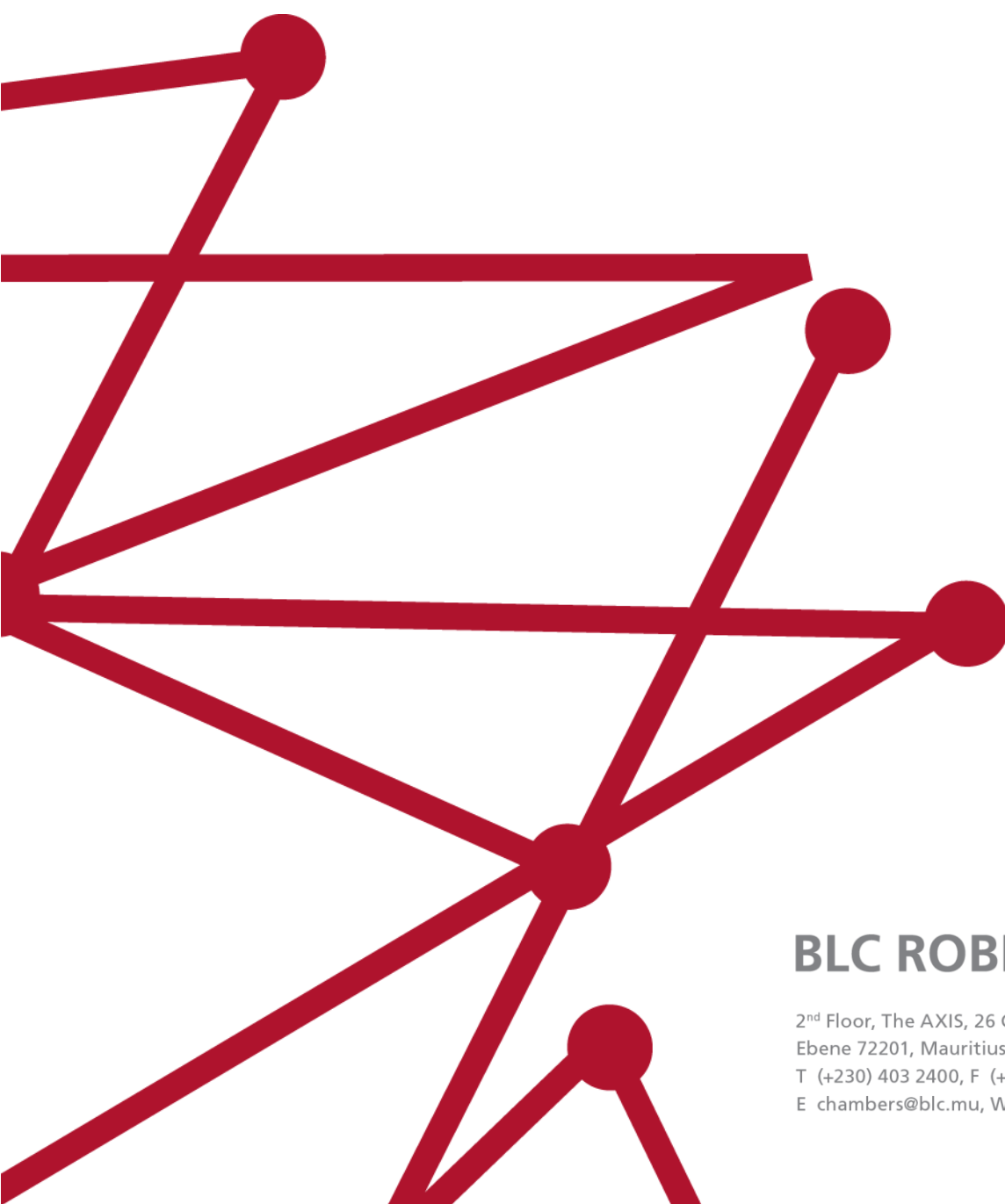

## BACKGROUND
